Install and test
carbon monoxide
alarms in your home.



Choose a generator
with CO shutoff /
CO Alert protection
when available.



Run your generator
outdoors only. Keep it
at least 20 feet away
from doors, windows,
and vents.



Point exhaust away
from your home and
occupied spaces.

Do not use a generator
in a home, garage,
basement, shed,
or carport



Do not place a
generator near open
windows, doors,
or under eaves.



Do not assume
carbon monoxide
will stay outside.



Do not ignore
symptoms like
headache, dizziness,
nausea, or confusion.
