

GENERATOR FIRE SAFETY

PORTABLE GENERATOR FIRE PREVENTION TIPS



DO THESE THINGS



Shut the generator off and let it cool before refueling.



Refuel outdoors and wipe up spills immediately.



Store gasoline in approved containers away from living areas.



Keep the generator clear of dry grass, leaves, paper, and other flammables.



Use only a weather cover or generator tent designed for operation.



DON'T DO THESE THINGS



Do not refuel while the generator is running or hot.



Do not place the generator against siding, decking, or near combustible materials.



Do not cover it with a tarp, blanket, or other flammable materials.



Do not overload cords or use damaged extension cords.



Do not smoke or use open flames near fuel.



HOT SURFACES + FUEL VAPORS CAN IGNITE QUICKLY.

Keep a fire extinguisher nearby and know how to use it.
