✓ **Set Up, Power, and Operate Safely**



DO THESE THINGS



Read the owner's manual before use.



Place the generator on a dry, level surface outdoors.



Use a transfer switch or inlet connection installed to code.



Use properly rated outdoor extension cords when needed.



Test the generator before an outage and keep oil / maintenance items ready.



Protect operation in wet weather only with a generator tent or approved operating cover.



A portable generator is only part of the backup power solution. Safe connection, ventilation, and maintenance matter just as much.



DON'T DO THESE THINGS



Do not backfeed a home through a wall outlet.



Do not use the generator indoors or too close to the house.



Do not operate in standing water.



Do not exceed the generator's rated capacity.



Do not skip maintenance or ignore warning lights / alarms.
